NOTICE

To the Bar Examinees:

1. **ALL BAR EXAMINEES** are **REMINDED** to observe the dress code stated in Reminder No. 4 of the **GUIDE AND RULES OF CONDUCT TO THE 2017 BAR EXAMINATIONS**, thus:

4. The conduct of the 2017 Bar Examinations is an official function of the Supreme Court, and is an integral part of every examinee's application for admission to the Philippine Bar. Thus, Bar Examinees are reminded to observe proper decorum, including dressing appropriately and comfortably. **Bar Examinees can wear only shirts with sleeves and collars, slacks or denim pants, below-the-knee length dresses or skirts, and closed shoes.**

The following kinds of attire are prohibited during the Bar Examinations:

- (a) Gauzy, transparent, or net-like clothing;
 - (b) Sandos; sleeveless, strapless, or spaghetti-strap blouses; tank tops (unless worn as an undershirt); cold-shoulder blouses; and blouses with over-plunging necklines;
 - (c) Micro-mini skirts; walking shorts; cycling shorts; leggings; tights; jogging pants; Capri pants; cropped pants; jeggings; stir-ups; distressed or torn jeans; pedal pushers; *culottes* or pajamas;
 - (d) Sandals; step-ins exposing the toes; rubber sandals; slippers; or *bakya*. (*Guide and Rules of Conduct to the 2017 Bar Examinations, Office of the Bar Confidant*)
2. After the Legal Ethics and Practical Exercises Examination, Bar Examinees can only exit through the España Gate of the UST Campus.
 3. Bar Examinees are discouraged from loitering inside the UST Campus after the last examination.
