

I-4	<p>The prospective bidder's computation of its Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) must be at least equal to the ABC of the lot to be bid, calculated as follows:</p> $\text{NFCC} = [(\text{Current Assets minus Current Liabilities}) \times 15]$ <p>minus the value of all outstanding or uncompleted portions of the projects under ongoing contracts, including awarded contracts yet to be started coinciding with the contract to be bid.</p> <p>The values of the bidder's current assets and current liabilities shall be based on the data submitted to the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR), through its Electronic Filing and Payment System (EFPS).</p> <p><i>(The NFCC shall be based on the 2018 Audited Financial Statement)</i></p> <p>Or, in lieu of the NFCC computation:</p> <p>A committed Line of Credit from a Universal or Commercial Bank (10% of the ABC).</p>

I-6	If applicable, the JVA in case the joint venture is already in existence, or duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners stating that they will enter into and abide by the provisions of the JVA in the instance that the bid is successful.
