
1. Pursuant to Resolution dated August 8, 2017 of the Supreme Court En Banc in A.M. No. 12-6-17-SC approving the recommendation to conduct negotiated procurement after two (2) failed biddings under Section 53.1 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", the Bids and Awards Committee for the Halls of Justice (BAC-HOJ) invites interested security agencies to participate in the negotiation for the security services for the Halls of Justice in the Autonomous Region for Muslim Mindanao with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Three Million Twenty Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty Pesos & 48/100 (Php3,020,930.48) for one (1) year. The delivery of security services for ARMM will be for a period of two (2) years.

2. Offerors should have completed, within ten (10) years from the date of submission and receipt of offers, a contract similar to the project equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.
3. The Eligibility and Technical Documents as well as the Financial Proposal be submitted on or before August 23, 2018, 9:00 a.m. at the Office of DCA Raul Bautista Villanueva, 3rd Floor, Old Building, Supreme Court, Padre Faura St., Manila.
4. An initial meeting for the negotiated procurement with interested security agencies will be conducted on August 7, 2018, 9:30 a.m., at the Office of DCA Raul Bautista Villanueva, 3rd Floor, Old Building, Supreme Court, Padre Faura St., Manila.
5. Opening of the eligibility documents, technical documents and financial proposal will be on August 23, 2018, 9:30 a.m. at the Office of DCA Raul Bautista Villanueva, 3rd Floor, Old Building, Supreme Court, Padre Faura St., Manila.
6. The Supreme Court of the Philippines, through the BAC-HOJ, reserves the right to accept or reject any offer, to annul the negotiation process, and to reject all offers at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to affected agencies.
