INVITATION TO BID FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF A WORKS CONTRACTOR/S FOR THE REPAIR AND REHABILITATION OF VARIOUS HALL OF JUSTICE IN REGION VIII

1. *The Supreme Court of the Philippines, through the Local Bank Account of the Supreme Court, intends to apply the total sum of **Forty-Two Million Five Hundred Ten Thousand Sixteen Pesos and 92/100 (₱42,510,016.96)** being the Approved Budget for the Contracts to payments under the contract for the **Repair and Rehabilitation of the Halls of Justice in Region VIII**, to wit:*

2. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
3. The *Supreme Court of the Philippines* now invites bids for repair and rehabilitation of the said Halls of Justice. A period of **One Hundred Fifty (150) Calendar Days** are required for the completion of the works for each project. Bidders should have completed a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instruction to Bidders.
4. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act.”
5. Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, cooperatives, and partnerships or organizations with at least seventy-five percent (75%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines and registered with the Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) with license category of at least **Small ‘B’** for general building.
6. Interested bidders may obtain further information *Supreme Court of the Philippines* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from **8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.**


9. The Pre-Bid Conference shall be open to all interested parties.
