BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE FOR HALLS OF JUSTICE

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR DETAILED ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING DESIGN (DAED) FOR THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF HALLS OF JUSTICE IN MIDSAYAP, NORTH COTABATO, MASBATE CITY, MASBATE AND PUERTO PRINCESA CITY, PALAWAN.

The Supreme Court of the Philippines, through its local bank account intends to apply the sum of:

Lot I	₱1,495,230.00	Midsayap, North Cotabato
Lot II	₱2,393,508.00	Masbate City, Masbate
Lot III	₱2,154,708.00	Puerto Princesa City, Palawan

being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for Design Consultancy Fee. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the opening of the financial proposals.

2. The Supreme Court of the Philippines now calls for the submission of eligibility documents for Detailed Architectural Engineering Design (DAED) . Interested consultants must submit one (1) original and three (3) copies of their eligibility documents on or before **09 December 2019**, at the Office on Halls of Justice, 7th Floor, Centennial Building, Supreme Court of the Philippines, Padre Faura, Ermita Manila. Applications for eligibility will be evaluated based on a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion.

3. The BAC shall draw up the short list of consultants from those who have submitted eligibility documents and have been determined as eligible in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations. The short list shall consist of maximum of five (5) prospective bidders who will be entitled to submit bids. The criteria and rating system for short listing are:

Experience of Consultant	50%
Qualification of Personnel (Principal and Key Staff)	30%
Current Workload and Financial Capacity/ Network	20%

4. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the IRR of RA 9184.

5. Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.

6. The Procuring Entity shall evaluate bids using the Quality-Cost Based Selection (QCBS), Fixed Budget Selection, or Least-Cost Selection] procedure. The technical proposal shall carry 70% weight while the financial proposal shall have 30% weight. Bid documents shall be available at cost to the shortlisted consultants at **Php5,000.00**
7. The contract shall be completed within four (4) months.
8. The Supreme Court of the Philippines reserves the right to reject any and all bids, annul the bidding process, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
