**BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE
FOR GOODS AND SERVICES (SC-BAC-GS)**

Resolution No. 2019-18

**RE: AWARD OF THE CONTRACT FOR THE
PROCUREMENT OF OFFICE SUPPLIES FOR
THE OFFICIAL USE OF THE LOWER COURTS**

WHEREAS, the SC-BAC-GS received the 1st Indorsement dated April 2, 2019 from the Procurement Planning Committee relative to the Procurement of Office Supplies for the Official Use of the Lower Courts with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the amount of Eleven Million One Hundred Fifty Thousand Seven Hundred Six Pesos and 52/100 (₱11,150,706.52) inclusive of taxes and freight costs;

WHEREAS, on the basis of the said Indorsement and after the conduct of the Pre-Procurement Conference on April 30, 2019, the SC-BAC-GS caused the posting of the Invitation to Bid on May 20, 2019 on the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement Service (PHILGEPS), the Supreme Court website and the bulletin boards within the Supreme Court premises;

WHEREAS, two (2) prospective bidders, MCsA Marketing and Triplex Enterprises, Inc., attended the pre-bid conference on May 28, 2019;

WHEREAS, two (2) prospective bidders, Triplex Enterprises, Inc. and DVK Philippines Enterprises, purchased the bidding documents and paid the non-refundable fee of Ten Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (₱10,750.00) to cover the cost for the preparation of the said bidding documents;

WHEREAS, on the day of the submission of bids and opening of bids on June 13, 2019, both Triplex Enterprises, Inc. and DVK Philippines Enterprises submitted their respective bids. Only DVK Philippines Enterprises was declared eligible and qualified after the opening and evaluation of its Eligibility/Technical and Financial Envelopes. Triplex Enterprises, Inc. failed to qualify due to its failure to completely fill up its Financial Bid Form;



WHEREAS, DVK Philippines Enterprises tendered its financial bid in the amount of *Ten Million Seven Hundred Eighty-Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Eight Pesos & 75/100 (P10,788,888.75)*. The bid was declared as the *Single Calculated Bid*, subject to post-qualification process;

WHEREAS, the notice for submission of post-qualification documents was issued on June 19, 2019 to DVK Philippines Enterprises which upon its receipt submitted the documents within the prescribed period;

WHEREAS, to verify, validate, ascertain the genuineness, validity, accuracy, and determine the responsiveness of the bid based on the documents submitted, post-qualification inspection was conducted by the SC-BAC-GS and the representatives of the end-user on July 3, 2019 which consisted of the ocular inspection of the premises and facilities of DVK Philippines Enterprises;


WHEREAS, in its Post-Qualification Report dated July 11, 2019, the post-qualification inspection team found no ground to post-disqualify the bid of DVK Philippines Enterprises;

WHEREAS, after review and evaluation of the findings of the post-qualification inspection team on DVK Philippines Enterprises' documentary submissions and the ocular inspection of its premises, the SC-BAC-GS is of the view that DVK Philippines Enterprises has met the requirements of the Supreme Court and declared its bid as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid;

NOW THEREFORE, We, the members of the SC-BAC-GS, hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED to:

1. recommend the award of the contract for the *Supply and Delivery of Office Supplies for the Official Use of the Lower Courts* to **DVK PHILIPPINES ENTERPRISES** in the amount of *Ten Million Seven Hundred Eighty-Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Eight Pesos & 75/100 (P10,788,888.75)*, inclusive of taxes and freight costs; and
2. request that **HON. JOSE MIDAS P. MARQUEZ**, Court Administrator, be authorized to sign the contract with the winning bidder.
