**REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE PROCUREMENT
OF CONSULTING SERVICES FOR DETAILED ARCHITECTURAL AND
ENGINEERING DESIGN AND FOR PROJECT MANAGEMENT
FOR THE PROPOSED CEBU CITY HALL OF JUSTICE**

1. The *Supreme Court of the Philippines*, through the Bids and Awards Committee for the Halls of Justice, intends to procure separately the following projects relative to the proposed construction of the Cebu City Hall of Justice:

Detailed Architectural and Engineering Design	<i>Seventeen Million Five Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Seven Pesos & 60/100 (P17,578,777.60)</i>
Project Management	<i>Twenty-Eight Million Five Hundred Ninety-Three Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Eight Pesos & 65/100 (P28,593,668.65)</i>

The foregoing Approved Budgets for the Contract are chargeable against the Local Bank Account of the Supreme Court which was earmarked and set aside for Infrastructure Development Projects in the Resolution dated June 5, 2018 of the Supreme Court En banc in A.M. No. 16-09-14-SC. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the opening of the financial proposals.

2. The *Supreme Court of the Philippines, through the Bids and Awards Committee for the Halls of Justice (BAC-HOJ)* now calls for the submission of eligibility documents for *Consulting Services for Detailed Architectural and Engineering Design and for Project Management for the Proposed Cebu City Hall of Justice*. Eligibility documents of interested consultants must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat on or before *November 10, 2020, 9:00 in the morning* at the *Office of Deputy Court Administrator Raul Bautista Villanueva, 3rd Floor, Old Building, Supreme Court, Padre Faura St., Ermita, Manila*. Applications for eligibility will be evaluated based on a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion. Prospective bidders are allowed to submit their eligibility documents, and be shortlisted, in ONE (1) PROJECT ONLY.

4. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders from the Office on Halls of Justice which shall be made available at cost to the shortlisted bidders in the non-refundable amount of *Twenty-Five Thousand Pesos (P25,000.00)*.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Supreme Court, provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

5. The BAC shall draw up the short list of consultants from those who have submitted Expression of Interest, including the eligibility documents, and have been determined as eligible in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). The short list shall consist of a *maximum of five (5) prospective bidders*, for each project, who will be entitled to submit bids. The criteria and rating system for short listing in both projects are:

<i>Experience of Consultant</i>	<i>Fifty Percent (50%)</i>
<i>Qualification of Personnel (Principal and Key Staff)</i>	<i>Thirty Percent (30%)</i>
<i>Current Workload and Financial Capacity/Networth</i>	<i>Twenty Percent (20%)</i>

6. Bidding for both projects will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the IRR of RA 9184.
7. Bidding for both projects is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, cooperatives, and partnerships or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.
8. The Procuring Entity shall evaluate bids using the *Quality-Cost Based Evaluation/Selection (QCBE/QCBS) procedure*. The Procuring Entity shall indicate the weights to be allocated for the Technical and Financial Proposals. The criteria and rating system for the evaluation of bids shall be provided in the Instructions to Bidders.
9. The contracts for the subject projects shall be divided in the following phases with their corresponding duration:

A. Detailed Architectural and Engineering Design

Pre-Design and Design Phase	Seven (7) months
Procurement Phase	Five (5) months
Construction Support Services Phase	Twenty-four (24) months
Post-Construction Support Services Phase	Twelve (12) months


B. Project Management

Evaluation Phase of the DAED Consultant Deliverables	Seven (7) months
Procurement Phase	Five (5) months
Construction Supervision Phase	Twenty-four (24) months
Post-Construction Phase	Twelve (12) months

10. The *Supreme Court of the Philippines* reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
