**REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR THE
PROJECT MANAGEMENT (PM) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE COURT OF APPEALS
STATION IN CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY**

1. The Supreme Court of the Philippines, through funds from the existing savings of the Court for Infrastructure Development Projects and pursuant to *Supreme Court Resolution* dated July 12, 2012 in A.M. No. 12-7-14-SC (*Re: Allocation of Amounts for the Construction Costs of the Manila Hall of Justice, the Cebu Court of Appeals Building, and Cagayan de Oro Court of Appeals Building*), as confirmed, approved, and iterated in the Supreme Court Resolution dated June 18, 2013, intends to apply the sum of **Seven Million Four Hundred Twenty Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (₱7,420,500.00)**, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC), for payments under the contract for Consultancy Services for the Project Management (PM) for the construction of the Court of Appeals Station in Cagayan de Oro City (CA-CDO). Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the opening of the financial proposals.
2. The Supreme Court of the Philippines now calls for the submission of eligibility documents for Consultancy Services for the Project Management for the construction of the CA-CDO Building, which shall consist of the following phases: (1) Evaluation of the Detailed Architectural and Engineering Design (DAED); (2) Procurement of Works Contractor; and (3) Supervision of Works Contractor, including all the relevant components thereof as specified in the Terms of Reference (TOR). The Project is located on a parcel of land measuring approximately 62,689.00 square meters, located at Barrio Indahag, Cagayan de Oro City, Province of Misamis Oriental. Eligibility documents of interested consultants must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat on or before **June 13, 2018, 9:30 a.m.** at the **Office of the Chairperson of the Bids and Awards Committee for the Constructions of the Manila Hall of Justice and the Court of Appeals Buildings in Cebu and Cagayan De Oro (BAC-MHOJ/CA-Cebu/CDO), 3rd Floor, Old Supreme Court Building, Padre Faura corner Taft Avenue, Ermita, Manila.** Applications for eligibility will be evaluated based on a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion.
3. Interested bidders may obtain further information from the Supreme Court of the Philippines and inspect the Bidding Documents at the Office of the Chairperson of the BAC-MHOJ/CA-Cebu/CDO, 3rd Floor, Old Supreme Court Building, Padre Faura corner Taft Avenue, Ermita, Manila, **Mondays to Fridays, 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.**

4. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on May 28, 2018 from the address indicated in No. 3 hereof. It may also be downloaded free of charge from the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) website at www.philgeps.gov.ph and the Supreme Court website at sc.judiciary.gov.ph, provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.
5. The BAC-MHOJ/CA-Cebu/CDO shall draw up the short list of consultants from those who have submitted their Eligibility Documents and have been determined as eligible in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 9184 (RA 9184) and the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”. The short list shall consist of **NOT MORE THAN SEVEN (7) prospective bidders** who will be entitled to submit bids. The criteria and rating system for short listing are:

CRITERIA	WEIGHT
Applicable experience of the consultant (consulting firm) and associates in case of joint ventures	50%
Qualification of principal and key staff of the consultant	30%
Current workload relative to capacity	20%
TOTAL	100%

The minimum score to qualify for shortlisting shall be **EIGHTY PER CENT (80%)**. It is further understood that a disqualification in any of the criteria would result to the interested consulting firm to be ineligible for shortlisting or for the award of the project.


6. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 9184. Bidding is open to all interested bidders, whether local or foreign, subject to the conditions for eligibility provided in the IRR.
7. The Procuring Entity shall evaluate bids using the **Quality-Cost Based Evaluation (QCBE)** procedure. The Supreme Court of the Philippines shall allocate seventy percent (70%) for the Technical Proposal and thirty percent (30%) for the Financial Proposal provided that the total weight given shall add up to one hundred percent (100%). The criteria and rating system for the evaluation of bids shall be provided in the Instructions to Bidders.

8. The Evaluation of the Detailed Architectural and Engineering Design (DAED), the Procurement of Works Contractor, and the Supervision of Works Contractor shall be completed within forty (40) months, and the contract will terminate after the issuance by the Supreme Court of the Philippines and receipt of the Civil Works Contractor of the Final Certificate of Acceptance for the Court of Appeals.
9. The Supreme Court of the Philippines reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
