**OF TWO HUNDRED TWELVE (212) SPLIT-TYPE AIR-CONDITIONING**  
**UNITS FOR THE FIRST AND SECOND LEVEL COURTS STATIONED IN THE**  
**DIFFERENT CITIES AND PROVINCES OF THE PHILIPPINES.**

- 1) The *Supreme Court of the Philippines*, through the Bids and Awards Committee for the Halls of Justice (BAC-HOJ), invites bids for the supply, delivery and installation of Two Hundred Twelve (212) Split-Type Air-Conditioning Units (Wall Mounted, Ceiling Mounted and Floor Mounted) for the first and second level courts stationed in the following regions for a total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the amount of **Twenty Seven Million Seven Hundred Fifty Eight Thousand Five Hundred Nine Pesos and 44/100 (P27,758,509.44)**:

- 2) Bids received in excess of the ABC for each lot shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
- 3) Bidders should have completed, within the last two (2) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project with at least 50% of the ABC for each lot to be bid. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II of the Instruction to Bidders.
- 4) Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".
- 5) Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183 and subject to Commonwealth Act 138.

- 6) Interested bidders may obtain further information from the *Supreme Court of the Philippines* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 8:00 in the morning until 4:30 in the afternoon.

- 11) Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders and/or their representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.
- 12) The *Supreme Court of the Philippines* reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders. In instances that may arise and not specifically mentioned herein, the *Supreme Court of the Philippines* shall resolve bidding issues by resorting to and applying the pertinent provisions of R.A. No. 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations.
