**Resolution No. 2019-15**

**RE: AWARD OF THE CONTRACT FOR THE  
COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH CARE PLAN OF  
THE SUPREME COURT FOR TWO (2) YEARS  
(JULY 1, 2019 TO JUNE 30, 2021)**

**WHEREAS**, the SC-BAC-GS received the 1<sup>st</sup> Indorsement dated March 19, 2019 from the Procurement Planning Committee relative to the *Procurement of the Comprehensive Health Care Plan of the Supreme Court for Two (2) Years (July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2021)*, with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the amount of One Hundred Forty Million Pesos (P140,000,000.00) inclusive of Value-Added Tax;

**WHEREAS**, on the basis of the said Indorsement and after the conduct of the Pre-Procurement Conference on April 3, 2019, the SC-BAC-GS caused the posting of the Invitation to Bid on April 8, 2019 on the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement Service (PHILGEPS), the Supreme Court website and the bulletin boards within the Supreme Court premises;

**WHEREAS**, seven (7) prospective bidders attended the pre-bid conference on April 16, 2019, namely:

1. Insular Health Care, Inc.
2. Cocolife
3. Medocare Health Systems, Inc.
4. Kaiser International Healthgroup, Inc.
5. Generali Philippines
6. First Life
7. Pacific Cross Insurance, Inc.

**WHEREAS**, the deadline of submission and opening of bids has been moved to May 6, 2019 due to the revision in the schedule of procurement activities;



**WHEREAS**, five (5) bidders purchased the bidding documents and paid the non-refundable fee of Thirty Thousand Pesos (P30,000.00) to cover the cost for the preparation of the said bidding documents, namely:

1. Cocolife
2. Philcare
3. Insular Health Care, Inc.
4. Medocare Health Systems, Inc.
5. Kaiser International Healthgroup, Inc.

**WHEREAS**, on the day of the submission of bids and opening of bids on May 6, 2019, two (2) bidders submitted their respective bids, namely:

1. Kaiser International Healthgroup, Inc.
2. Medocare Health Systems, Inc.

Both were declared eligible and qualified after the opening and evaluation of their respective Eligibility/Technical and Financial Envelopes;

**WHEREAS**, the financial bid offered by the bidders were as follows:

Kaiser International Healthgroup, Inc.	<b>P127,777,964.16</b>
Medocare Health Systems, Inc.	<b>P131,991,900.00</b>

**WHEREAS**, the financial bid offered by Kaiser International Healthgroup, Inc. in the amount of *One Hundred Twenty-Seven Million Seven Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-Four Pesos and 16/100 (P127,777,964.16)* was declared as the Lowest Calculated Bid, subject to post-qualification process;

**WHEREAS**, the notice for submission of post-qualification documents was issued on May 8, 2019 to Kaiser International Healthgroup, Inc. which upon its receipt submitted the documents within the prescribed period;

**WHEREAS**, to verify, validate, ascertain the genuineness, validity, accuracy, and determine the responsiveness of the bid based on the documents submitted, post-qualification inspection was conducted by the SC-BAC-GS, technical working group and the representatives of the end-user on May 22, 2019 which consisted of the ocular inspection of the premises and facilities of Kaiser International Healthgroup, Inc.;

**WHEREAS**, in its Post-Qualification Report dated May 27, 2019, the post-qualification inspection team found no ground to post-disqualify the bid of Kaiser International Healthgroup, Inc.;



**WHEREAS**, after review and evaluation of the findings of the post-qualification inspection team on Kaiser International Healthgroup, Inc.'s documentary submissions and the ocular inspection of its premises, the SC-BAC-GS is of the view that Kaiser International Healthgroup, Inc. has met the requirements of the Supreme Court and declared its bid as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid;

**NOW THEREFORE**, We, the members of the SC-BAC-GS, hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED to recommend the award of the contract for the *Comprehensive Health Care Plan of the Supreme Court for Two (2) Years (July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2021)* to **KAISER INTERNATIONAL HEALTHGROUP, INC.** in the amount of **One Hundred Twenty-Seven Million Seven Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-Four Pesos and 16/100 (P127,777,964.16)**, inclusive of Value Added Tax (VAT).


