**RE: AWARD OF THE CONTRACT FOR THE
PROCUREMENT OF SERVICE VEHICLES FOR
THE OFFICIAL USE OF THE JUSTICES OF THE
SUPREME COURT - LOT 1: THREE (3) UNITS
OF SEDAN**

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods and Services (SC-BAC-GS) received Indorsements from the Procurement Planning Committee (PPC) relative to the *Procurement of Service Vehicles for the Official Use of the Justices of the Supreme Court - Lot 1: Three (3) Units of Sedan*, with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P7,500,00.00) inclusive of Value-Added Tax;

WHEREAS, on the basis of the said Indorsements and after the conduct of the Pre-Procurement Conferences on January 22, 2019 and March 12, 2019, the SC-BAC-GS caused the posting of the Invitation to Bid on March 18, 2019 on the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement Service (PHILGEPS), the Supreme Court website, and bulletin boards within the Court's premises starting on even date;

WHEREAS, during the pre-bid conference on March 26, 2019, six (6) prospective bidders and their representatives attended the pre-bid conference, namely:

1. Toyota Otis, Inc.
2. Toyota Pasong Tamo, Inc.
3. Areza Motor Sales
4. Toyota Makati, Inc.
5. Toyota Quezon Avenue
6. Mazda Greenhills

WHEREAS, only Toyota Makati, Inc. purchased the bidding documents and paid the non-refundable fee of Seven Thousand Pesos (P7,000.00) to cover the cost for the preparation of the said bidding documents;

WHEREAS, on the day of the submission of bids on April 10, 2019, only Toyota Makati, Inc. submitted its bid and was declared eligible and qualified after the opening and evaluation of its Eligibility/Technical and Financial Envelopes;



WHEREAS, Toyota Makati, Inc. tendered its financial bid in the amount of *Five Million, Seven Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (P5,733,600.00)* and was declared as the Single Calculated Bid, subject to post-qualification process;

WHEREAS, the notice for submission of post-qualification documents was issued on April 15, 2019 to Toyota Makati, Inc. which upon its receipt submitted the documents within the prescribed period;


WHEREAS, to verify, validate, ascertain the genuineness, validity, accuracy, and determine the responsiveness of the bid based on the documents submitted, post-qualification inspection was conducted by the SC-BAC-GS and the representative of the end-user on April 25, 2019 which consisted of the ocular inspection of the premises and facilities of Toyota Makati, Inc.;

WHEREAS, in its Post-Qualification Report dated April 26, 2019, the post-qualification inspection team found no ground to post-disqualify the bid of Toyota Makati, Inc.;

WHEREAS, after review and evaluation of the findings of the post-qualification inspection team on Toyota Makati, Inc.'s documentary submissions and the ocular inspection of its premises, the SC-BAC-GS is of the view that Toyota Makati, Inc. has met the requirements of the Supreme Court and declared its bid as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid;

NOW THEREFORE, We, the members of the SC-BAC-GS, hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED to recommend the award of the contract for the *Supply and Delivery of Service Vehicles for the Official Use of the Justices of the Supreme Court - Lot 1: Three (3) Units of Sedan* to **TOYOTA MAKATI, INC.** in the amount of *Five Million, Seven Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (P5,733,600.00)*, inclusive of Value Added Tax (VAT).
