Interested applicants for the position of **Deputy Ombudsman for Military and Other Law Enforcement Offices** and for the recently opened **judgeship positions in the National Capital Judicial Region (NCJR)** must register in the JBC Online Application Scheduler (OAS) on or before **29 April 2021** and select therefrom the available date they will submit their documents. After the said deadline, the OAS would then be deactivated. Considering the meritorious requests of several applicants for the extension of time to submit their lacking documentary requirements owing to the difficulty in securing documents due to the physical closure of courts and other offices as a result of the imposition of the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) and Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) in the NCJR and in nearby provinces, the JBC resolved to extend the deadline for the submission of the documentary requirements to **31 May 2021** (Monday). The online scheduler will remain accessible until midnight of the original deadline of 29 April 2021. Only the submission of documentary requirements of those who were able to secure a schedule would be extended until 31 May 2021.
