As discussed during the Pre-Bid Conference held today, please be informed of the following clarifications:

(A) the following certifications as required in the **Technical Documents** that should be contained in the bidding documents should state that the bidder fully paid its contribution as of May 31,2021:

Certifications from <u>each</u> of the following government agencies, that bidder has religiously paid its contributions with respect to its security service contracts, government or private-

- (i) Social Security System;
- (ii) State Insurance Fund (Employees' Compensation);
- (iii) PAG-IBIG Fund; and
- (iv) PHILHEALTH Insurance contributions as mandated by law.

If no certification has yet been issued for the required period, a certification may be submitted showing latest proof of remittance and an explanation why the bidder was unable to submit a certification of its updated contributions.

However, despite the submission of such certification and explanation as part of its bidding documents, the bidder shall be required to present the required certification (as of May 31, 2021) during post-qualification and failure thereof shall be a ground for the disqualification of the bidder.

(B) As to the type of firearm required in No. 3 of Section VII Technical Specifications in the Philippine Bidding Documents for Procurement of Security Services in the Halls of Justice of Various Regions, please be informed that only a 9mm caliber is required.

Furthermore, the ratio of the number of firearm for each Security Guard on duty for each shift is 1:1

Please be guided accordingly.
