Notice is hereby given of the revisions made in the bidding documents and the answer to pending queries raised by prospective bidders, upon consultation with the representatives of the implementing office:

<i>Queries</i>	<i>Answers</i>
As to the Single Largest Completed Contract	
Are body cameras acceptable as similar contracts for the requirement?	Acceptable.
As to the Technical Specifications	
Are headphones with built-in microphones acceptable and compliant with the required technical specification?	Not acceptable and not compliant.
In case of defective units, replacement is required onsite or in the Supreme Court?	Replacement is required onsite for courts located in the NCJR, Region 3 and Region 4. For the rest of the regions, replacement is to be made in the Supreme Court.
Can we relax the warranty period to one (1) year instead of two (2) years?	No, warranty period is two (2) years.
As to the Requirement on Item I-11 of the Bid Data Sheet on the “Certification/s of at least “Satisfactory” Performance from at least three (3) clients of a completed contract. If the bidder has been a previous supplier of the Supreme Court, a certificate of at least “Satisfactory” Performance” must be submitted.”	
Should the required “Certification/s of at least “Satisfactory” Performance from at least three (3) clients of a completed contract” pertain to only to a similar contract or to all other kinds of contracts?	Yes, the required certification/s of at least “Satisfactory” Performance pertains to similar contracts only.



<p>In case the prospective bidder has been a previous supplier of the Supreme Court, should the required certificate of at least “Satisfactory Performance” to be submitted likewise pertain to similar contracts only?</p>	<p>No, the required certification/s of at least “Satisfactory” Performance is not limited to similar contracts only.</p>
