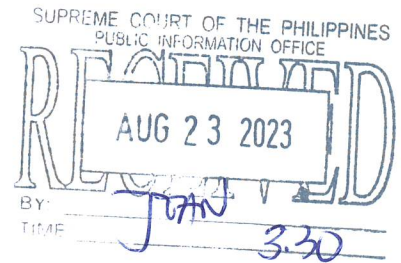

## BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE FOR THE HALLS OF JUSTICE

### INVITATION TO APPLY FOR ELIGIBILITY AND TO BID FOR THE SUPPLY, DELIVERY, AND INSTALLATION OF SPLIT TYPE AIR-CONDITIONING UNITS IN THE HALLS OF JUSTICE NATIONWIDE

1. The *Supreme Court of the Philippines*, through the amount allotted for *Machinery and Equipment Outlay, under the General Appropriations Act for FY 2023 (R.A. 11936)* intends to apply the sum of *Twenty Seven Million Twelve Thousand Eight Hundred Eight Pesos and 2/100 (₱27,012,808.02)*, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contracts for the *Supply, Delivery and Installation of Split Type Air-Conditioning Units in the Hall of Justice Nationwide*:

III	Visayas	69 Units	₱8,107,407.05
IV	Mindanao	12 Units	₱1,101,428.20

Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

2. The *Supreme Court of the Philippines* now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. The completion of delivery is required for a period of *One Hundred Twenty (120) Calendar Days for Lots I, II, III and IV*. Bidders should have completed within *Five (5) Years* from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary “*pass/fail*” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (R.A. No. 9184).
4. Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the law or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to R.A. No. 5183.
5. Prospective bidders may obtain further information from the *Supreme Court of the Philippines* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 8:00 in the morning until 4:30 in the afternoon.



The prospective bidders shall, before purchasing the Bidding Documents, coordinate with the Secretariat so they may be assisted in making their payments to the Cashier Division, Fiscal Management and Budget Office, Supreme Court. The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees in person.

7. The **Supreme Court of the Philippines** will hold a **Pre-Bid Conference on August 29, 2023, (Tuesday), 9:30 a.m. through videoconferencing/webcasting via Zoom** which shall be open to prospective bidders. The Zoom ID and password shall be provided to the interested bidders prior to the Pre-Bid Conference.
8. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the Office of the Deputy Court Administrator for Luzon, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Old Building, Supreme Court, Padre Faura St., Ermita, Manila on or before **September 12, 2023, Tuesday, 9:00 a.m.** The prospective bidders are advised to coordinate with the Secretariat the expected date and time of the submission of their Bid Documents so they may be properly assisted. Late bids shall not be accepted.
9. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB** Clause 14.
10. Bid opening shall be on **September 12, 2023, Tuesday, 9:30 a.m.** at the Office of the Deputy Court Administrator for Luzon, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Old Building, Supreme Court, Padre Faura St., Ermita, Manila. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives through videoconferencing via Zoom.
11. The **Supreme Court of the Philippines** reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
