ANNOUNCEMENT

<i>Qualifications:</i>	Must be a natural-born citizen of the Philippines, preferably a member of the Philippine Bar and must have held the rank of at least a full Colonel in the AFP or the PNP, or an Assistant Director in the NBI, with experience in investigation in all instances: <i>Provided</i> , That a Chief Marshal may be appointed despite not having been a full Colonel of the AFP or the PNP, or an Assistant Director of the NBI, if he or she has a proven track record and adequate experience in investigation and law enforcement. ²

<i>Office:</i>	Office of the Deputy Marshal for Luzon
<i>Item No.:</i>	DEPMA-NEW1-2023
<i>Salary Grade:</i>	29
<i>Qualifications:</i>	Must be a natural-born citizen of the Philippines, and must have held the rank of at least a full Colonel in the AFP or the PNP, or an Assistant Regional Director of the NBI, with experience in investigation in all instances: <i>Provided</i> , That a Deputy Marshal may be appointed despite not having been a full Colonel of the AFP or the PNP, or an Assistant Regional Director of the NBI, if he or she has a proven track record and adequate experience in investigation and law enforcement. ³

<i>Qualifications:</i>	Must be a natural-born citizen of the Philippines, and must have held the rank of at least a full Colonel in the AFP of the PNP, or an Assistant Regional Director of the NBI, with experience in investigation in all instances: <i>Provided</i> , That a Deputy Marshal may be appointed despite not having been a full Colonel of the AFP or the PNP, or an Assistant Regional Director of the NBI, if he or she has a proven track record and adequate experience in investigation and law enforcement. ⁴

<i>Qualifications:</i>	Must be a natural-born citizen of the Philippines, and must have held the rank of at least a full Colonel in the AFP of the PNP, or an Assistant Regional Director of the NBI, with experience in investigation in all instances: <i>Provided</i> , That a Deputy Marshal may be appointed despite not having been a full Colonel of the AFP or the PNP, or an Assistant Regional Director of the NBI, if he or she has a proven track record and adequate experience in investigation and law enforcement. ⁵
