Sirs/Mesdames:

*Please take notice that the Court, Second Division, issued a Resolution dated **March 1, 2023** which reads as follows:*

“G.R. No. 264583 (GT7 MANAGEMENT SERVICES, INC. / JAMES GO - OWNER AND MALOU CALAMA* - OPERATION MANAGER, AND BF BESTFRIEND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, Petitioners v. MAMERTO C. CANAMASO AND CESAR S. FAJARDO, Respondents). –

This is a Petition for Review on *Certiorari*¹ assailing the Resolutions dated December 21, 2021² and October 27, 2022³ of the Court of Appeals (CA) in CA-G.R. SP. No. 170235 which dismissed GT7 Management Services, Inc. and BF Bestfriend Development Corporation’s Petition for *Certiorari*⁴ for failure to comply with the material date rule and the requirement of proof of service on Mamerto C. Canamaso and Cesar S. Fajardo (respondents), and for submitting a defective verification and certification against forum shopping.⁵

Considering the allegations, issues, and arguments adduced in the Petition for Review on *Certiorari*, the Court finds no cogent reason to deviate from the CA’s ruling that the Petition is procedurally defective. However, the Court deems it proper to impose legal interest at the rate of 6% per annum on the total monetary awards that the National Labor Relations Commission granted to respondents pursuant to prevailing jurisprudence.⁶

FOR THESE REASONS, the Petition is **DENIED**. The Resolutions dated December 21, 2021 and October 27, 2022 of the Court of Appeals in



CA-G.R. SP. No. 170235 are **AFFIRMED**. The Decision dated February 28, 2020 of the National Labor Relations Commission is **MODIFIED** in that legal interest at the rate of 6% per annum is imposed on the total monetary awards computed from the finality of this Resolution until full payment.
