MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE AND ADMIT

RESPONDENT COMMISSION ON **ELECTIONS** (COMELEC), through the Office of the Solicitor General (OSG), with leave of court, simultaneously herein prayed for, to this Honorable Court, respectfully states:

MANIFESTATION

- In its Motion for Leave to File the Attached Counter-Manifestation with Motion to Dismiss dated 25 January 2024, the COMELEC, among others, apprised the Honorable Court of the timeline and the details of what transpired before its Special Bids and Awards Committee (SBAC) relative to the procurement process in the Lease of Full Automation System with Transparency Audit/Count (FASTrAC) for the 2025 National and Local Elections (NLE).
 - 1.1. Particularly, consequent to the declaration of the Joint Venture - Miru Systems Co. Ltd., Integrated Computer Systems, St. Timothy Construction

Corporation and Centerpoint Solution Technologies, Inc. (Miru JV) as the lone bidder that submitted the Single Calculated Bid (SCB), the Technical Working Group (TWG) was tasked to conduct a post-qualification evaluation in accordance with Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9184, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), and the SBAC's timeline of procurement activities on 09 to 31 January 2024.

- 2. The COMELEC respectfully informs the Honorable Court that the TWG has concluded its post-qualification of Miru JV.¹
- 3. After a careful examination, validation, and evaluation of eligibility documents, *i.e.*, *legal*, *technical*, *and financial*, the SBAC then declared JV Miru as the post-qualified bidder with the *Single Calculated and Responsive Bid* for the Lease of FASTrAC for the 2025 NLE,² with the following details:

4. In the same *Memorandum*, the SBAC also recommended the following:

- (i) Issuance of a *Notice of Award* to Miru JV for the Lease of FASTrAC for the 2025 NLE;
- (ii) Request the Head of the Procuring Entity to authorize Honorable Chairman George Erwin M. Garcia to sign the Notice of Award, Contract, and Notice to Proceed on behalf of the COMELEC; and,
- (iii) Require Miru JV to post performance security in an amount equal to a percentage of the total contract price in accordance with the following schedule:

- 5. In the Minute Resolution No. 24-0114³ dated 21 February 2024, the COMELEC *En Banc* approved the recommendation of the SBAC.
- 6. In addition, the COMELEC *En Banc* required Miru JV to submit a Supply and Delivery Management Plan within ten (10) calendar days upon receipt of the Notice of Award, pursuant to COMELEC Minute Resolution No. 22-1073, as stated in ITB Clause 12.2 of Section III-Bid Data Sheet of the Bidding Documents.
- 7. The COMELEC notes that the delivery or contract implementation will proceed after issuance of the corresponding Notice of Award, Contract, and Notice to Proceed in favor of Miru JV.
- 8. Verily, the timely award of the FASTrAC contract is vital to the other activities⁴ scheduled by the COMELEC for the orderly and credible elections.
 - 8.1. After the procurement process, the COMELEC is scheduled to conduct a five-month long system customization for FASTrAC.
 - 8.2. Thereafter, the final system for FASTrAC is scheduled to be delivered on 01 August 1 2024, but not later than 30 October 2024. Only then can the conduct of the local source code review be made.
 - 8.3. Eventually, the Automated Election System is set for field testing on 30 November 2024. To ensure transparency, several public demonstrations are likewise scheduled on 18 December to 30 April 2025.
 - 8.4. Simultaneous with all these pre-election preparations are the recruitment and conduct of trainings for the procured FASTrAC.

9. All told, COMELEC's exercise of its constitutional mandate is dependent on the timely conduct of these preelection activities.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, premises considered, respondent COMELEC respectfully prays that the foregoing *Manifestation* be **ADMITTED** and **NOTED**.

Other just and equitable reliefs under the premises are likewise prayed for.





